



## Academy Division

### **AGE REQUIREMENT:**

**17 and Under or Having High School Eligible as of July 15, 2010**

The 2009 Academy **Division** will kick off June 5, 2010. As in the past this league will be primarily a weekend league with two or three games each weekend. **All teams will be scheduled for some mid week dates depending on field and team availability.** Various High School and College facilities will be used for games. We plan to have a minimum of four locations allowing teams to play closer to their home base.

### **Organizational Affiliations:**

This year's teams will be affiliate with three different National Organizations:

- Continental Amateur Baseball Federation (CABA) 17 & Under
- United States Amateur Baseball Federation Inc (USABF)
- American Amateur Baseball Congress (AABC / Don Mattingly & Connie Mac)

These three organizations have National Tournaments and SDEBL teams are encouraged to participate in as many events as they can fit into their summer schedule. If you commit to one of the events you will be expected to fulfill your commitment in order to be in good standing with the San Diego Elite Baseball League. Teams determined not to be in good standing will be precluded from participating in future play.

### **League Website:**

The San Diego Elite Baseball League website is located at [www.sdelitebaseball.com](http://www.sdelitebaseball.com) The league schedule, team rosters, sponsors and additional contact information will be available on the website. This information is extremely important to ensure that our league participants receive visibility by National Collegiate Recruiters and Major League Baseball Scouts. Each team is encouraged to solicit sponsors and have them published on the website. Additional sponsorship information can be found at this website.

### **League Schedule:**

The League will schedule 15 games for each team. History has proven that most teams have difficulty playing any more than 15 games due other events such as CIF Playoff's, Showcases and other tournaments. It will be your responsibility to select playable dates and to ensure your team meets its commitments.

This year's league tournament will be played July 15 – 18, 2010. The winner will receive a berth into the USABF Academy Division World Series. The team's entry fee will be waived for all players listed on your official League / Tournament Roster, any Players not listed on the League / Tournament roster will be required to pay the World Series event fee \$50. Admission will be charged for the League Tournament and World Series events. Adults \$7.00 and Youth \$3.00

The 2009 summer schedule will run from June 5 – July 11, 2010. All teams are required to submit their league participation dates no later than April 1. The schedule will be published on or about May 1.

### **San Diego Elite Baseball Classic: (Aluminum Bat)**

**Thursday, June 10 - Sunday, June 13**

All teams in the league will participate and play a minimum of 3 games. These games count toward your 15 league games, no additional team entry fees will be charged. Admission will be charged. (Adults \$7.00 and Youth \$3.00) Additional non-League teams may participate in this event but will be required to pay the \$550 entry fee. The winner will receive an automatic berth into the USABF Aluminum Bat World Series, team fees will be waved for those listed on the San Diego Elite Baseball Roster, if additional players are added they will be responsible for a \$50 player fee.

### **League Championships:**

**Thursday, July 15 - Sunday, July 18**

All teams must be in good standing, which includes completion of all games scheduled. Seeding for the League Championships will be determined based on overall league records (win percentage). This Tournament will be Double Elimination. The winner will receive a berth into the AABC Regional's, this year's event is being hosted in Washington. The League will pick up the cost of Lodging (3 Players per room).

### **League Fees:**

Fees for the 2010 Summer League will be \$3,100. The fee includes the cost of Umpires, Umpire Scheduling, Field Rental, Field Maintenance, Insurance, Organizational Affiliations, and Administration costs.

### **League Registration:**

League membership will be limited to 8 teams per division. Don't be left out. All teams should pre-register and provide a non-refundable deposit of \$250.
